

Sue Pritt from Sweet Season Quilts will be spending some time with our guild during the month of September. On Friday evening, September 14 at 7:00 p.m., Sue will present a lecture/trunk show at the Malone Adult Center. The title of her lecture is "Sweet Season Quilts". She will talk about her beginnings in quilt making with a trunk show of her early "office quilts". She will also include some of her favorite techniques including: the process of making her patterns using simple piecing, quilting as you go, and fusible web machine applique. She will have more trunk show quilts demonstrating the techniques and handouts for all in attendance.

On Saturday, the 15th, Sue will offer a workshop. Participants may choose from seven patterns. Fee is \$35 per person which includes one pattern and "jump start" sheets and instruction. Pre-printed fusible web sheets are available for an additional \$5. Not necessary, but nice to have!

We have to have a minimum of 8 quilters to take the class. Participants will need to sign up and pay at the June meeting. If you cannot be at the meeting, but you wish to take the class, call me (518-353-1788). I will send the signup sheet to Sue. She will mail the kits to me and I will distribute them.
